St. Andrew's Mission Hospital Clinic

- This clinic offers general medical consultations for adults and children.
- Patients under 19 years old will be charged at a subsidised rate.
- This clinic provides:
 - Non - emergency general medical consultation
 - Medical examinations: pre-employment assessments, work permit holders, foreign domestic workers, pap smear tests (by appointment only)
 - Vaccinations: e.g. for Tetanus, Hepatitis B and Influenza
 - Medical review for renewal of driving license
 - Wound dressing

Specialist Clinic in Rehabilitation Medicine

- Specialist consultation is by appointment only.
- To make an appointment, please call 6586 1025 during office hours.

Patient Education Service

- Outpatients and their caregivers may obtain guidance and education from a nurse on self-management of their illness. For example:
 - Appropriate care and management of wound dressings
 - Care of and management of nasogastric tubes and urinary catheters
 - Home monitoring of blood pressure and/or blood glucose



Consultation with a senior nurse is by appointment only. To make an appointment or enquiry, please call 6586 1025 during office hours.

DAY REHABILITATION CENTRE

- Provides outpatient rehabilitation services for patients to help improve their condition and achieve specific rehabilitation goals.
- Its Active Rehabilitation Programme is an individualised programme planned and implemented by a physiotherapist and/or an occupational therapist.

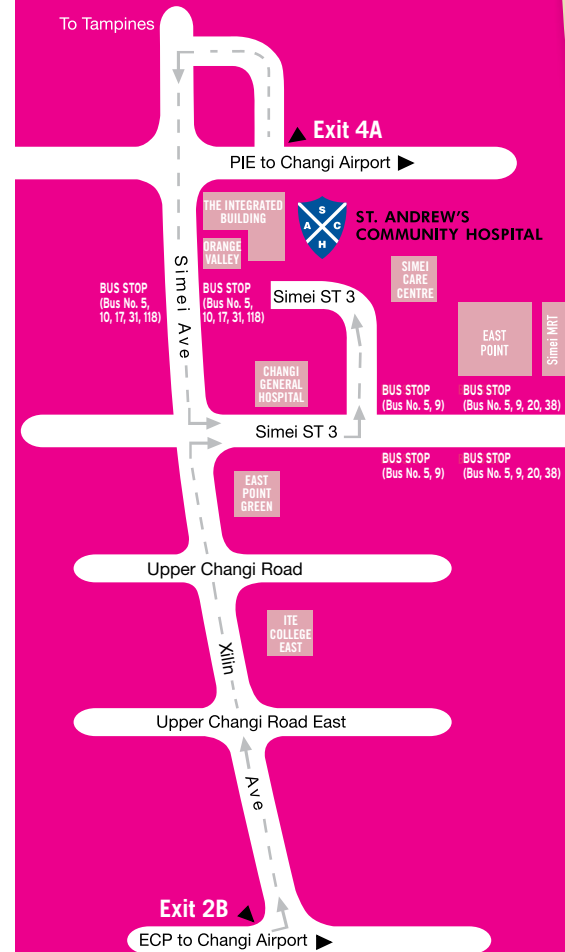

On 18 November 2011, SACH joined Changi General Hospital, SingHealth Polyclinics, and The Salvation Army Peacehaven Nursing Home (and later, the Health Promotion Board) as founding members of the Eastern Health Alliance (EH Alliance). The Alliance works to deliver seamless, high quality and patient-centred care services for the better health of people in Eastern Singapore.

INPATIENT SERVICES

St. Andrew's Community Hospital (SACH) provides subsidised rehabilitative and sub-acute care for adult and paediatric patients after their acute phase of treatment at an acute care hospital.



Rehabilitative Care

- Provides physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy and music therapy for patients.
- Patients undergo 2 to 4 weeks of rehabilitation to help them get back to their best possible function.

Dementia Care

- Provides customised therapy sessions and social programmes for patients with dementia and requiring rehabilitative care.

Sub-Acute Care

- Provides care for patients recovering from medical conditions.

Palliative Care

- Provides specialised care to patients with life-limiting illness and relief from their symptoms.



Accommodation

- Wards are located in the SACH Main Building and the Integrated Building (beside SACH).
- Well-ventilated open wards of 5-bedded and 8-bedded cubicles with shared common bathrooms.

Admission

Referral through the Agency for Integrated Care (AIC) is required for subsidised care. SACH accepts referral from

- Restructured and private hospitals
- General practitioners or medical specialists
- St. Andrew's Mission Hospital Clinic

Caregiver Involvement

- Upon admission, patient's family is required to identify a caregiver to work closely with SACH in planning the patient's discharge care plan.
- SACH strongly encourages caregivers' involvement every step of the way as they play an important role in patients' recovery journey.



Discharge Planning

- If medication is prescribed for patients by our doctors upon patient's discharge, our pharmacist will counsel the patient and/or caregiver before dispensing medication.

Visiting Hours

- Visiting hours are from 12:00 PM to 9:00 PM.
- Visitors who are unwell are advised to refrain from visiting the hospital.
