St. Andrew's Community Hospital (SACH) Day Rehabilitation Centre (DRC) provides active sessional rehabilitation services including Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy. This comprises strengthening, stretching, ranging, balance and functional training, so as to optimise patients' ability to participate in activities of daily living. Speech Therapy and Music Therapy are also available to patients upon request.

The DRC seeks to help patients with conditions such as:

- Stroke
- Dementia
- Parkinson's Disease or other neurological conditions
- Traumatic brain injury
- Fracture
- Musculo-skeletal conditions, e.g. Osteoarthritis
- De-conditioning after an illness or operation



The DRC is also set up to train patients in activities of daily living in a realistic environment. Different sections in the DRC feature replicas of a kitchen, bedroom, and minimart. Training in these settings helps patients regain their confidence and ability to navigate and function independently at home and in the community.

Admission
