#### PRIMARY CARE PLAN FOR WORKERS

The Ministry of Manpower requires all employers of migrant workers (work permit holders and S Pass Holders) who live in dormitories or work in the Construction, Marine Shipyard and Process (CMP) sectors to purchase a Primary Care Plan (PCP) from Anchor Operators for their employees.

The PCP is designed to cover most of the migrant workers' primary care needs, and give migrant workers greater peace of mind when accessing primary healthcare.

St. Andrew's Migrant Worker Medical Centre (SAMWMC) is the Anchor Operator for Zone F.

Employers are charged \$108 per worker (rate before GST) annually for a PCP.

#### Workers must also pay additional fees

Medical treatment per visit \$5 (rate before GST)
Telemedicine service per usage \$2 (rate before GST)

# **SCOPE OF SERVICES UNDER PCP**

- Consultation and treatment for acute or chronic medical conditions
- · One medical examination for work pass application or renewal
- Scheduled transportation to and from dormitories for those reporting sick
- Telemedicine including online consultation and delivery of medication

Annual health screening

# **VALIDITY**

PCP is valid for 1 year on an auto-renewal basis unless terminated by the employer.

# **RANGE OF SERVICES**



#### **Primary Care**

Treatment of acute conditions such as upper respiratory tract infections and management of chronic conditions such as diabetes mellitus and hypertension

#### **Medical Examination**

Physical examination, blood tests and X-rays for work pass applications and renewals

Therapy exercises to improve muscle strength, flexibility and mobility as well as relieve pain
